

REED TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

April 27, 2022

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Sherrill Knorr.

The Pledge was done at the hearing just before the regular board meeting.

Those present at roll call were Trustee Scott Favero; Trustee Steve Bolatto; Trustee Pam Tessler. Also present were Assessor Mary Jones, Highway Commissioner John Dixon, and Supervisor Sherrill Knorr.

A motion to approve the March minutes was made by Trustee Steve Bolatto; second by Trustee Pam Tessler. There was no discussion; motion carried.

A motion to approve the treasurers report was made by Trustee Scott Favero; second by Trustee Steve Bolatto. A reminder that the statement is a month behind, so the statement is for March 2022. All in favor; motion carried.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Trustee Pam Tessler; second by Trustee Scott Favero. Supervisor shared that Mike Kavanaugh will also install the door May 7th, he will be paid for installation when it is completed. Assessor Mary Jones asked about needing new keys? Supervisor said using the same lock, push bar, but will need new keys. All in favor; motion carried.

Supervisor shared that IMRF will go down so the town will pay less. Also talked to Kari Lynn, the attorney, and she will work on the resolution to sell the property that is surplus and approved at the Annual Town Meeting. There are some issues on the lot such as neighbor running his gutters to the lot but that can be taken care of. Due to an incident, we need security so someone has been contacted. Clerk asked what they would install? They will check on camera, buzzer, or ring door bell.

Highway commissioner shared they received the new truck and running boards and the bill for Grundy County is to reclaim the shoulders. There is a culvert plugged on County Line we cannot dig until we call Julie. A motion to approve the highway bills was made by Trustee Steve Bolatto; second by Trustee Pam Tessler. All in favor; motion carried.

The assessor shared that Kari and Eric went to a Pam's Pro class in Wilmington. Eric will be hired to do data entry for the assessor department. Dan Altiery resigned. Doing senior freezes, but now people can go to Wilmington in June and the county will be doing the senior freeze. County has set a date and place, that has been shared on our board, it has been put in the local paper so people will know they can go and get this taken care of.

There was no clerk report.

There was no trustee report.


There was no unfinished business.
