The Reed Township Board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Sherrill Knorr at 4:32 pm.

The Pledge was said by all.

Those present at roll call were Trustee Scott Favero, Trustee Steve Bolatto, Trustee Pam Tessler, Trustee Adam Beaty, and Supervisor Sherrill Knorr. Also present were Highway Commissioner John Dixon, Assessor Mary Jones, Assistant Clerk Debra Lavicka, and Township Clerk Tom Nahas.

A motion to approve the May minutes was made by Trustee Favero; seconded by Trustee Bolatto. No discussion; all in favor, with Trustee Beaty abstaining, motion carried.

### Treasurer Report:

The Treasurer report was presented.

A motion to approve the Treasurer's report (Account balances for May) was made by Trustee Tessler; seconded by Trustee Bolatto. There was no discussion; all in favor, motion carried.

### Town & General Bills:

A motion to approve the bills for Town and General was made by Trustee Beaty Second by Trustee Tessler. No further discussion, all in favor, motion carried.
