

REED TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

May 25, 2022

The Township Board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Sherrill Knorr.

The Pledge was done by all.

Those present at roll call were Trustee Scott Favero, Trustee Steve Bolatto, Trustee Adam Beaty, Trustee Pam Tessler, Highway commissioner John Dixon, and Supervisor Knorr.

A motion to approve the budget hearing minutes, held just ahead of the regular meeting on April 27, 2022, was made by Trustee Favero, second by Trustee Steve Bolatto. There was no discussion. Due to his absence at the hearing Trustee Beaty did an abstention. Trustees Favero, Bolatto, and Tessler, along with Supervisor Knorr voted yes. Motion carried.

A motion to approve the regular monthly minutes was made by Trustee Scott Favero; second by Trustee Steve Bolatto. There was no discussion. All in favor; motion carried. Trustee Beaty die an abstention.

A motion to approve the treasurers report was made by Trustee Scott Favero; second by Trustee Pam Tessler. Just a reminder this is the statement as the end of April all in favor; motion carried.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Trustee Pam Tessler; second by Trustee Steve Bolatto. Trustee Adam Beaty questioned the size of the water bill? Supervisor Sherrill Knorr explained the hall had been rented a lot and the floors were also cleaned this month. Also, the clay pool drainage went up to \$26 on the tax bill for the year, and this is something that the township does pay. All in favor of the motion; motion carried.

The supervisor shared that when Springfield passed the new amount of spending for the township without going out for bid, they only did Town not highway. Township will be \$30,000.00 but highway will remain at \$20,000.00. When Springfield reconvenes in the fall, they will work on the highway portion of the bill.

Highway Commission is looking into changing the salt spreader going from chain to auger. A motion to accept the highway bills was made by Trustee Steve Bolatto; second by Trustee Pam Tessler. There was no discussion. All in favor; motion carried.

There was no assessor report.

The Clerk Angie Hutton shared the time and place for the Memorial Day Event given by the American Legion.

There was no trustee report.

There was no executive session.

Supervisor shared Kari Lynn, township attorney, worked on a resolution to sell the property that was declared surplus at the Annual Town Meeting. To sell the property there are steps to follow; we need state approved appraiser, cost of what the property is worth and then sell for a certain percentage of the property worth. Highway Commissioner suggested Kim Motta, Supervisor Knorr will contact Kim and see if she or her office meet the qualifications. Once all the pre requisites are done then we will post in the paper.

Supervisor asked about a donation to National Night Out held in August by our police department. She shared that her and Angie worked the event last year with a question wheel on township facts. It was enjoyed by everyone! Supervisor asked if the board would like to make a donation, \$100 was given previously or you can do more or less.

There was no public comment.

A motion to adjourn was made by Trustee Pam Tessler, second by Trustee Steve Bolatto. All in favor; motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 4:49 P.M.

The assessor Mary Jones was absent the entire meeting.
