- Have entered a great number of properties into the system already and they are working 2 days a week.
- Contacted Cindy Harris that has retired from Will County Assessor's Office and is interested in being a temporary assessor until we have someone full time to fill that position; she does NOT want to be full-time. She will start Monday.
- Working on budgets over the next few weeks.

Highway:

- Commissioner Dixon reports they are doing maintenance on equipment and doing cold patching rods.
- I was contacted by the mayor of Godley, and she thinks that Reed Township should take over the roads, and I told her that we do not do any roads. Then she asked about us mowing out on 53 and I said no to that as well, that is a state highway.

- We had an accident out on North Center St on the bridge, a driver was reaching for a cup of coffee, and he took out the guard rail and besides that the wing wall fell down. I talked to Will County and after waiting 10 days for information to contact his insurance. County will help out if we put a pipe under it. Still waiting for further information regarding insurance.
