### **Minutes Approval:**

A motion to approve the May minutes was made by Trustee Favero; seconded by Trustee Tessler. There was no further discussion; roll call vote: all in favor, motion carried.

Noted that air conditioning/furnace was replaced and there is a bill for A1 Heating and Cooling for \$9200 that failed and was better to completely replace the old system. No further discussion, roll call vote: all in favor, motion carried.

### **Supervisor Report:**

- Got a packet from the City of Braidwood regarding the annexation of property; and Assessor Money described the approval of the new gas station where the Good Table Restaurant was located at Division St. and Coal City Rd. They are building on 5 ½ acres and the Good Table

location was already in Braidwood but the land to the south of it they had to purchase, that comes to around 27-28 acres, was not and they had to annex that in and change the zoning on it. They had to approve 3 variances on it, one was the height of the sign, the width of the sign and one other minor one that he could not remember. This was all approved and the city was just notifying us of this.

**Highway:**

- Cmsr Dixon stated that the salt shed is done.
- The city is looking to get the same contractor to do theirs.
- Did the second mowing.
- Will be going out for bid to resurface the road going out to the cooling lake.

The highway bills were presented.
