October 30th, 2024, Meeting Minutes

The Reed Township Board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Sherrill Knorr at 4:30 pm.

The Pledge was said by all.

Those present at roll call were Trustee Scott Favero, Trustee Adam Beaty, Trustee Pam Tessler, Trustee Ken Corbin and Supervisor Sherrill Knorr. Also present were Township Clerk Tom Nahas, Deputy Clerk Debra Lavicka, and Assessor Doug Money.

Minutes Approval:

A motion to approve the April minutes was made by Trustee Beaty; seconded by Trustee Corbin. There was a comment by Trustee Favero to replace the name of the person referred to as "Buzz" with his real name which is: Bill Smith. Other than that, there was no further discussion; roll call vote to accept the minutes with the change: all in favor, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:

The Treasurer's report was presented.

A motion to approve the Treasurer's report (Account balances for September) was made by Trustee Beaty; seconded by Trustee Tessler. No further discussion; vote: all in favor, motion carried.

Town & General Bills:

A motion to approve the bills for Town and General was made by Trustee Favero and seconded by Trustee Tessler.

No further discussion, roll call vote: all in favor, motion carried.

Supervisor Report:

- New gutters with gutter screens on building.
- Buried the downspout feed to the drain rather than just onto the sidewalk.
- Conference coming up.

Highway:

- Commissioner Dixon was absent, but here is what happened.
- Wants to go out for bid for 2700 feet on access road to the cooling lake south end.
 - Discussed whether it is in Will or Kankakee County and it is in Will.
- All locks in the highway department have been re-keyed.
- Had some repairs done to the truck and pickup truck.
- Had some trees removed on South Center St.
- Had to get repairs done to the gas line outside the building and repairs to the phone lines due to damage during some digging.
- Citizen's gas was down to \$90 this month, down from \$600.
- Also, no word on what is going on with North Center St., it is actually the City's.

The highway bills were presented.

A motion was made by Trustee Favero to approve the Highway Commissioners report and seconded by Trustee Tessler.

A roll call vote was taken; the motion carried with all in favor.

Assessor report: Got our official numbers from the county and we have added \$5,321,394 to the tax rolls from buildings that have never been assessed. Finished our filing and all is in order and the window is closed now for the year, so we are catching up and getting ready for the new year.

Clerk report: Working on the books and filing.
